<p>With the vision of contributing to the improvement of success in global new drug development and becoming the world hub of clinical trials, Korea Clinical Trials Global Initiative (KCGI) was launched by the Ministry of Health and Welfare in 2014.</p> <p>KCGI is a government-funded R&D program that supports setting up of research infrastructure and operational systems in clinical trials centers (CTC) of major leading academic medical institutions. The Global Centers of Excellence (GCE) Project of KCGI mainly supports building of research infrastructure that will enable CTCs to become global leaders in early phase development in specialized therapeutic areas or areas of unmet needs. GCE Project selected five consortia of university hospital CTCs, each of which is composed of two to five CTCs from different university hospitals.</p> <p>The aim of the seminar is to introduce specialized R&D resources at the Global Global Centers of Excellence (GCE) and seek for collaboration strategy with Industrial Partners for new drug development.</p>
